AWARDS

Guaranteed \$1000 in prize money to be divided between Champions from each division!

Open Classes: Trophies for first place and ribbons first through sixth place.

Championship Classes: Champion and Reserve Champion receive Prize money and an embroidered saddle pad; Ribbons first through sixth place.

HDS High Point Trophy will be given to Amateur, Junior and Open rider with the highest score for the show.



2010 HDS RECOGNIZED SCHOOLING SHOW CHAMPIONSHIP 2010 QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS AND PERCENTAGES

All HDS members with registered Horse and Rider combinations are eligible for the HDS Recognized Schooling Show Championship if the following conditions apply:

- Participants must be 2010 HDS Horse and Rider Members in good standing. Rider and Horse Championship
- Participants must have been a 2010 HDS horse and rider member *at the time of obtaining qualifying scores at 2010 HDS Recognized Schooling Shows.*
- Qualifying Scores must be obtained at 2010 competition year (Jan – Dec 2010) HDS Recognized Schooling Shows;
- Each rider must declare the division in which they are competing prior to each attempt at a qualifying ride at HDS Recognized Schooling Shows or for a score submitted under HDS requirements (Amateur, Open, or Junior/Young Rider) and must provide proof of eligibility in the case of Amateur and Junior/Young Riders.
- Each horse/rider pair must comply with 2010 HDS Recognized Schooling Show Requirements and competition rules.
- Horse/Rider combinations can only be ridden in classes in two (2) consecutive levels (i.e., Training and 1st Level).

To be eligible for Championship classes, horse and rider combinations must obtain two (2) Qualifying Scores (Percentages) at 2 different shows with 2 different judges per the following table. *Qualifying scores may be obtained in the 2010 competition year by riding ANY test of the USDF level offered.*

ENTRIES

Participants must be 2010 HDS Horse and Rider Members in good standing. Rider and Horse Championship participants must have been a 2010 HDS horse and rider member at the time of obtaining qualifying scores at 2010 HDS Recognized Schooling Shows.

Competition Entry Limit: Show/Classes will be limited to the First 40 Entries received by the Show Secretary.

Payment: *Make checks payable to Houston Dressage Society* or fill out credit card form (available on HDS website, VISA M/C only) and **send to Show Secretary** with entry. *No postdated checks accepted.*

A copy of a **Coggins Test** taken *within 12 months of the show dates* must accompany each entry.

All fees must be paid and information supplied before receiving packet. Entries are accepted on a first come, first-served basis, based on postmark date and entries shall be limited. Those entries postmarked after closing will be accepted at the discretion of the show secretary and show committee, based on a space available basis and charged a \$30 late fee. If the classes are oversubscribed, a Waiting List (in the order of draw) will be maintained. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Cancellations: **Prior to closing date entries will be refunded, less office fee. After closing date, no refunds.** HDS and Show Management reserve the right to cancel any classes due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accident, or emergency. Every effort will be made to reschedule with priority given to any qualifying classes being offered. No refunds for cancellations due to hazardous weather, Acts of God, accidents or emergencies.

Official Ride Times will be posted on the HDS and/or Sienna Stables web site approximately two weeks before the show and E-mailed to the rider approximately one week prior to the shows. If rider does not have E-mail, then hard copy will be mailed.

Stabling: *All competing horses must be stabled on the show grounds-no trailer tying allowed. Stalls are permanent, 12X12 with solid walls and doors. Shavings will be provided with each stall (Cost included in stall fee). Tack stalls provided (Contact show Management for details) Stall charts will be posted and check-in will start at 4:00 PM on evening prior to show.*

Early arrivals and late departures are only available by arrangement with the Show Manager at \$30/night/horse.



Stalls must be vacated by 8:00 PM on the day of the show, except by prior arrangement with show management.

No smoking in the barns and near the indoor warm-up arenas. Designated smoking areas will be provided.

Scores: It is the responsibility of the competitor to verify the accuracy of all scores. Scoring errors must be reported to the Show Secretary within one hour of the official posting of the scores from the last class of the show day during which the score was earned.

Arenas/Footing/Warm-Up: All tests and warm-up will be ridden in either indoor or outdoor arenas with sand/clay footing. Lunging permitted in designated outdoor areas only. Arenas close at TBD pm. Schedule for schooling will be posted at the show grounds. Large arenas are 20m X 60m. Intro, Training (non qualifying) and First Level Test 1 classes may be ridden in a small arena 20m X 40m.

Dress: (Refer to 2010 HDS Recognized Schooling Show Requirements located on www.houstondressagesociety.org) One whip no longer than 47.2 inches (120 cm), including lash may be carried in all Championship classes. An adjustable-length whip may **not** be carried by a mounted rider.

Execution and Judging of Tests: After the sound of the bell, the competitor should enter the arena at A as soon as possible. Exceeding 45 seconds before entering the arena after the bell has sounded will entail elimination. No competitor can be required to ride prior to his scheduled time.

Local Veterinarian/Farrier: Phone numbers and information will be posted at the show grounds and in the show secretary's office prior to the start of the show.

Numbers: Numbers must be worn at all times when a horse is out of its stall. Each horse/rider combination is considered a separate entry and must fill out a separate entry form and will be issued a different number.

Rule Enforcement: All rules will be enforced from the time a competitor arrives on the show grounds. (Refer to 2010 HDS Recognized Schooling Show Requirements located on www.houstondressagesociety.org)

Signatures: Any and all riders, trainers, owners, agents, lessees, parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, and coaches of horses (or riders) are required to sign an entry blank and must be HDS members or pay a non-member fee.

Show management rights: reserves the right to limit entries, add, combine or divide classes, modify the schedule, add substitute or change officials, modify or cancel awards and prizes and/or make whatever changes are required by circumstances to the competition specifications listed herein. Scheduling priority will be given to Championship classes. Show management reserves the right to cancel classes insufficiently filled and to refuse or require withdrawal of an entry for cause deemed sufficient by show management.

Concessions: available at show grounds. **Dogs:** Well behaved dogs on leash allowed.
